Scholarship Qualifications

1. Be enrolled at either East, West or Expo High Schools in the Waterloo School district or a member of the Waterloo Warriors Hockey Team.
2. Plan to attend an accredited public college or university or vocational technical school or any other accredited post-secondary institution as a full-time student starting in the fall 2021.
3. Applicants must be pursuing a career in the arts (computer graphics, painting, design, etc.) or a skilled trade area (auto repair/mechanics, welding or carpentry). We are looking for someone who is quietly but diligently pursuing his/her passion. This motivation/intent should be reflected in your essay. The donor's intent is to award this scholarship to a student who has similar talents that Todd possessed.

Essay Requirements

1. Please attach one typed-written page addressing the following:
 - a. What are you passionate about in the area of arts (computer graphics, painting, design, etc.) or skilled trade area (auto repair/mechanics, welding or carpentry)?
 - b. What are your post-secondary educational goals and how will you achieve them?
 - c. What are your long-term or career goals/plans, how do you intend to achieve them, and why did you choose these goals/plans?
 - d. What personal characteristics or experiences qualify you to receive a scholarship?

Required Attachments

1. One-page essay (see above for content requirements).
2. A letter of recommendation emphasizing leadership qualities from a teacher, principal, counselor, church leader, community leader, or employer (not a family member).
3. Most recent school transcript.

Other

1. **Applications must be received at the Waterloo Community Foundation office by the end of business day Thursday, March 4, 2021. Late applications not accepted. Our building is NOT open to the public at this time to allow for hand-delivered applications.**
2. Selection of scholarship recipient based on thoroughness of application, essay, transcript and letter of recommendation.
