



## LIZ CROWLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 4, 2021    VALUE: \$500**

*The Liz Crowley Memorial Scholarship is dedicated to the memory of Liz Crowley, a native of Waterloo and long-time educator, including principal at the Dr. Walter Cunningham School for Excellence in Waterloo. Applicants must be pursuing a degree in education, be a student at East, West or Expo in Waterloo, maintain minimum 3.0 grade point and plan to attend an accredited post-secondary institution as a full-time student fall of 2021. Two (2) \$500 scholarship are offered annually.*

### **Scholarship Qualifications**

1. Be enrolled at either East, West or Expo high Schools in Waterloo.
2. Plan to pursue a degree in education and attend an accredited public or private college or university, vocational technical school or another accredited post-secondary institution full-time starting in fall of 2021.
3. Must have a 3.0 grade point average or higher.

### **Essay Requirements**

1. One-page typed essay covering the following topics:
  - a. What influenced you to pursue a degree in education?
  - b. What are your post-secondary educational goals and how do you hope to achieve them while attending college?
  - c. What are your long-term or career goals/plans, how do you intend to achieve them, and why did you choose these goals/plans?
  - d. What personal characteristics or experiences qualify you to receive a scholarship?

### **Required Attachments**

1. One type-written page essay (see above for content requirements).
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation emphasizing leadership qualities from a teacher, principal, counselor, church leader, community leader, or employer (not a family member).
3. Most recent school transcript.

### **Other**

1. **Applications must be received at the Waterloo Community Foundation office by the end of business day Thursday, March 4, 2021. Late applications not accepted. Our building is NOT open to the public at this time to allow for hand-delivered applications.**
2. Selection of scholarship recipient based on thoroughness of application, essay, transcript and letter of recommendation.
