The Hubert & Georgia Rossin Scholarship is inspired also by the belief the Rossins exemplified every day: that every child deserves a loving and supportive home. This scholarship is dedicated to those wonderful individuals who sacrificed to positively make the difference in and to the life of a child by providing a loving home to those in need.*

### **Scholarship Qualifications**

1. Senior enrolled in an accredited public or parochial school in Waterloo.
2. Must have been or is currently residing in a foster care home.
3. Must be in good standing at their school.
4. Must plan to attend either a two-year or four-year college/university full-time in fall of 2021 or be actively completing a certification program of study full-time fall of 2021.

### **Essay Requirement**

1. Please attach two essays. Each essay should not exceed two 8x11 pages and should be spaced at 1.5 with a font size not to exceed 11.
  - a. Essay #1: Write about your goals and aspirations for the future.
  - b. Essay #2: Write about the impact the foster care system has had on your life.

### **Required Attachments**

1. Two essays (see above for content requirements).
2. Two letters of recommendation. Letters should be one page in length and speak to the applicant's character and why they should be granted the scholarship.
3. Most recent school transcript.

### **Other**

1. **Applications must be received at the Waterloo Community Foundation office by the end of business day Thursday, March 4, 2021. Late applications not accepted. Our building is NOT open to the public at this time to allow for hand-delivered applications.**
2. Selection of scholarship recipient based on thoroughness of application, essays, transcript and letters of recommendation.
